

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION (T&C)

This T&C sets out the general terms and conditions governing the contract concluded in connection with the application for and participation in the 2nd International Basketball Conference (date: 23–24 July 2022, place: Rátgéber Basketball Academy, Pécs, Hungary (Pécs, Megyeri út 74/1, 7632), hereinafter referred to as: Conference) organized by NKA Nonprofit Kft. (seat: 7632 Pécs, Megyeri út 74., comp. reg. no.: 02-09-084850, hereinafter referred to as: Organizer) and the rights and obligations of persons (hereinafter referred to as: Participant) applying to the Conference.

Registration for the Conference is considered an order and entails the obligation to pay the participation fee.

If the registration is done through the website, the Organizer will issue a proforma invoice to the applicant. The contract between the Parties is concluded by the voluntary registration of the Participant, the acceptance of the Privacy Policy and the T&C, and the download of the proforma invoice. The contract will be concluded between absent Parties. The contract does not qualify as a written contract, it will not be registered, so it will not be available afterwards.

The participation fee includes the amount of VAT.

The Participant may pay the participation fee by bank transfer to the bank account number provided on the proforma invoice by the specified deadline. The date of payment of the participation fee is the day when the participation fee arrives in the Organizer's bank account. Financial payment of the full amount of the participation fee on time is a condition for participation in the event. The issued invoice will be sent to you electronically and, if requested, by post.

Tickets purchased for the Conference are non-transferable.

Please note that due to the close date of the Conference, we will not be able to refund the participation fee if the Participant cancels.

The Organizer has the right to cancel the Conference in the event of force majeure. If the Conference is canceled due to force majeure, the Organizer will refund the fees already paid, less administrative costs.

The Organizer will make every effort to ensure that the program is carried out as advertised. However, it reserves the right to change the program, the topic and the start date of the lectures.

It is forbidden to make any audio, photo or video recordings at the Conference without the permission of the Organizer.

The Participant has the right to participate in the Conference, take notes and use the published materials for his own purposes. The applicant is not entitled to transfer his rights under this T&C.

During the conference lectures, the Participant may not behave in any way that would disrupt the course of the program. The Participant is obliged to follow the rules of the Conference venue. He is fully liable for any damage caused.

The lectures given at the Conference are the intellectual property of the speakers. Further use of the lecture (publication, lecture, presentation, education, sales, distribution, etc.) is only possible with the prior written permission of the lecturer. The further use of the written materials (professional journal, etc.) available at the Conference is possible only with the indication of the source.

We would like to inform you that photo and video recordings may be made at the Conference, on which recordings the visitors of the event may be recognizable. The recordings may be published by the Organizer on its online interfaces (e.g. Facebook, Instagram, website, etc.), in printed publications or handed over to the press for further use. By entering the area of the event in the knowledge of this information, you consent to the data management by implied conduct. If you do not want to be recognized on the recordings, please let the organizers know when you enter the event.

This T&C will take effect on the day of its publication and will be valid until revoked. The Organizer reserves the right to modify the T&C. The amendment is effective from the date of publication.

Issues not regulated in the T&C are governed by the Hungarian law.
